

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-02

VILLAGE OF BROWNSVILLE, DODGE COUNTY, WISCONSIN

An Ordinance Designating the Village Clerk/Treasurer to Issue Operator's Licenses

Whereas, Wis. Stats. sec. 125.17(1) provides in part as follows:

Every municipal governing body shall issue an operator's license to any applicant who is qualified under s. 125.04 (5), except that the municipal governing body may by ordinance authorize a designated municipal official to issue operator's licenses.

Whereas, the Brownsville Village Board desires to designate its Village Clerk/Treasurer as its municipal official to issue alcohol beverages operator's licenses, without the need for Village Board approval, consistent with sec. 125.17(1).

Now, Therefore, the Village Board of the Village of Brownsville, Dodge County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Brownsville Municipal Code Sections 5.04(1)(g)(1) and (2) are amended to read as follows:

(g) Issuance of Operators' Licenses.

1. Authorization. The Village Board, or the Village Clerk/Treasurer, may issue operators' licenses for the purpose of complying with §§125.32 (2) and 125.68 (2), Wis. Stats. Operator's licenses may be issued only upon written application. The Village Clerk/Treasurer, hereby designated to issue operator's licenses, may issue operator's licenses without the need for Village Board approval, pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 125.17(1).

2. Validity. Operators' Licenses issued pursuant to the Brownsville Municipal Code are valid only within the Village of Brownsville.
