Dennis Kemmel nominated Timothy Kemmel for Presidential Candidate, second by Troy Kemmel.

John Pesch asked for further nominations three times. Being no further nominations for Village President the nominations were closed. Motion to close by Jeffrey Bloohm, second by Charles Dineen.

#### Nominations for Village Trustee Candidate: 2 positions open

Dennis Kemmel nominated Philip Bloohm for Trustee candidate, second by John Pesch.

Charles Dineen nominated Jeffrey Westphal for Trustee candidate, second by John Pesch.

Adam Lechner nominated Timothy Kemmel for Trustee candidate, second by Charles Dineen.

John Pesch asked for further nominations three times. Being no further nominations for Village Trustees the nominations were closed. Motion to close nominations by Jeffrey Bloohm, second by Trustee Dineen.
