PUBLIC COMMENTS: One citizen made public comments to the Board.

Motion by Trustee Pesch, second by Trustee Dineen, to adopt RESOLUTION NO. 2021-01 A Resolution to Approve Construction Contract of Brownsville Chemical Phosphorus Removal Upgrade with MZ Construction Inc., to approve the Agreement with MZ Construction Inc. to construct a WWTF Chemical Phosphorus Removal Upgrade, and to approve the Notice to Proceed for the WWTF Chemical Phosphorus Removal Upgrade; motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. 5-aye.

Motion by Trustee Pesch, second by Trustee Kemmel, to approve RESOLUTION NO. 2021-02: A Resolution to Approve Borrowing for the WWTF Chemical Phosphorus Removal Chemical Upgrade of \$100,000.00 for 10-years at a rate of 3.15% from National Exchange Bank and Trust; motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. 5-aye

Motion by Trustee Pesch, second by Trustee Westphal, to approve RESOLUTION NO. 2021-03: A Resolution to approve additional Borrowing for the Purchase of Brownsville Community Center Furnaces of \$26,000.00 to be added to the existing Community Center Loan with National Exchange Bank at a rate of 2.75% and increase the term by an additional year (2025); motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. 5-aye

Motion by Trustee Kemmel, second by Trustee Dineen, to approve rental of the Brownsville Community Center to the Lomira Legion and Ladies Auxiliary for a May 31, 2021 Memorial Day Breakfast at a rate of \$100.00 for the day; motion carried. 4-aye 1-nay

Motion by Trustee Pesch, second by Trustee Dineen, to approve a sewer credit of \$162.00 (20,000gal @ \$8.10 per thousand) to Jeffrey Westphal, 730 Ledgeview Ln., due to an equipment malfunction in his home; motion carried. 4-aye Trustee Westphal abstained.

SAFEbuilt - building permits issued were reviewed by Board.

- Valves at the water plant are being replaced at an approx. cost of \$250.00 per valve.
- Snowfall this year has kept the team busy.
- Light bulbs in the big diamond's overhead lights, covered by previous donations, are planned to be replaced this year.
